



# Q1. Is there any age limit to apply for undergraduate program?

#### A. No.

There's no specific age limit as long as the applicants meet the requirements.

## Q2. Can I apply if I already graduated from high school a long time ago?

#### A. Yes.

#### Q3. I am a university student. Can I transfer to KAIST?

#### A. No.

We regret to tell you that **KAIST does not have transfer system**. You will be enrolled as a freshman, regardless of your major at another college.

However, you may be able to receive credits for the courses you have taken at your previous university, but the final decision will be made by your department. It is up to each department to decide whether or not they will approve transfer credits.

# Q4. I am a homeschooler (or a GED student). Can I apply?

A. No.

### Q5. I hold a foreign citizenship. But, my mom is Korean. Am I eligible?

If either of your parents is Korean national, you're not eligible to apply.

However, if you have completed your entire education (from Grade 1 to 12) outside of Korea, then you are eligible to apply.

## Q1. Is there any minimum score for the Standard Official Tests to apply for KAIST?

#### A. No.

KAIST does not have a minimum score for the Standard Official Test Scores. Yet, it is highly recommend that applicants submit test scores that demonstrate high proficiency in math and science, particularly in physics, chemistry, or biology.

#### Q2. Can I apply with the predicted scores?

#### A. Yes, for IB or GCE A-level test takers.

For IB or GCE A-level test takers, we accept predicted score reports that are written and verified by a counselor or teacher at the school. However, admitted applicants must submit their official IB diploma/GCE certificate as soon as it is received. Please refer to the page 10 of the admission guideline for the details.

### Q1. Is Duolingo English test score recognized for English Proficiency Test Score? No. We regret to tell you that Duolingo is not recognized. Only TOEFL, TEPS, **IELTS, TOEICs are accepted.** Duolingo

## Q2. I don't have any English Proficiency Test scores, but I have SAT score. Is SAT be recognized for EPT score?

#### A. No.

Q3. I don't have any English Proficiency Test score, but I'm fluent in English and the medium of instruction in my high school was English. Can I get exempted for it?

#### A. Yes.

Please note that you need to **submit an official certificate issued by your high school** stating that the medium of instruction is English.

#### A. No.

# Q5. Is there any minimum score for English Proficiency Tests to apply for KAIST?

#### A. No.

There is no minimum score for EPTs. However, It is strongly recommended that applicants obtain a score of above TOEFL iBT 83, TEPS(NEW) 326, IELTS 6.5, or TOEIC Listening and Reading 720.

## Q1. How can I apply for KAIST scholarship? What's the minimum requirements for it?

Every admitted international student is granted a full-ride KAIST scholarship. If you do not have any external scholarship, you can simply apply for KAIST scholarship when completing your application form. And once you're admitted, you will get the KAIST scholarship.

#### Q2. What benefits would I get from KAIST scholarship?

- The KAIST scholarship for international undergraduate students includes:
  - Full tuition exemption for 8 semesters
  - Monthly stipend of KRW 350,000 for 8 semesters
  - National Health Insurance

\* It doesn't cover the airfare nor the dormitory fee.
